

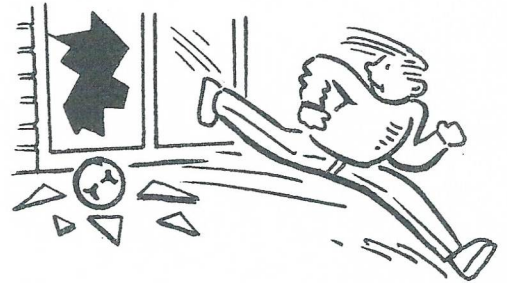


# Proofreading

1. Bill was caught running away from a broke window. "I didn't do nothing," he said. "It weren't me who break the window. Harry were kicking a ball about. He must of done it."



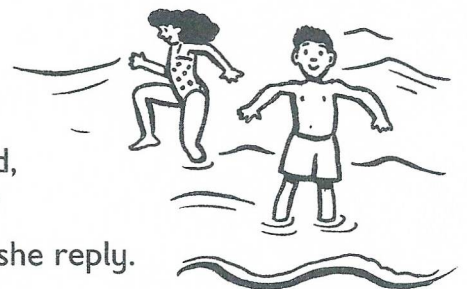

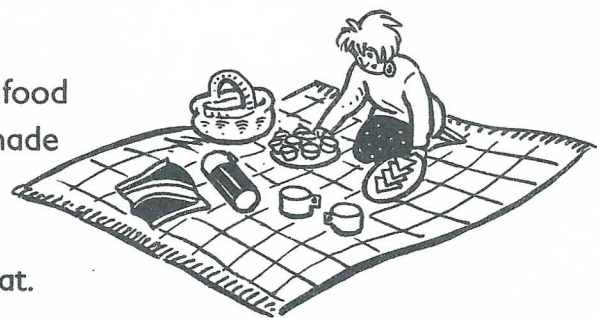
