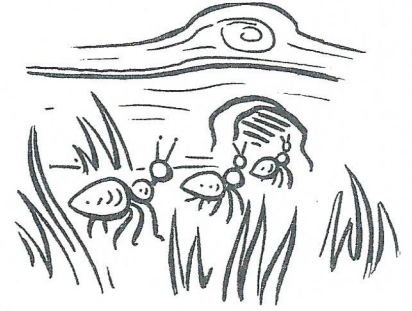




Proofreading for spelling and punctuation
