Find information from different sources and show understanding of internet safety.  
Use ICT to present work.

Activities will include:

Painting and printing. Make comparisons between their work and the work of others.

Activities will include: Conversations, recounts, reports Read own work and the work of others. Read picture books and books about Wales  
Write postcard, email, letter, recount, book reviews and character descriptions

Activities will include:  
Multi skills - Learn and develop skills to be able to take part in games.  
Swimming daily for 1 week.

Adventurous activities - work as a team to complete challenges

Activities will include:  
Listening to music from the war years. Sing a range of war time songs.  
Discuss, analyse and compare. make comparisons between songs then and now.

### History

Activities will include:  
Life during the war years - find out about people, places, events. Why were children evacuated? What was home life like? Food and rationing. The role of women.  
Ask and answer the questions - What do you know about life at this time; how do you know this and how can you find out more? Were there significant changes in people's lives at this time? What impact did people of this time have on their environment?

### Mathematics

KS2 activities will include: Place value, ordering, rounding. Temperature, negative numbers. Properties of numbers, number sequences. Reasoning about numbers. Understanding + - x and ÷ Mental and written strategies Making decisions, checking results, using a calculator. Measures, including problems -time, weight, mass, capacity. Angle and position. Money and 'real life' problems Fractions Handling data. Using data skills Graphs and charts Collect and record data Present and analyse data Interpret results. Function machines Area and volume. Decimals and percentages Probability expressions and formulae

Key Stage 2 English - activities will include  
Dialogue and play scripts - role play, writing and reading  
Explanation texts, reading writing and discussing  
Character descriptions, biographies and autobiographies  
Poetry

All children will complete a range of reading and oracy tasks as well as narrative/story telling.
