### This term our theme is 'Potions' The skills we are learning are:

## In Topic we will...

#### <u>History</u>

- Describe some of the main events, people and changes.
- Give some of the causes and consequences of the main events and changes and start to make links between them

#### <u>Geography</u>

- Show knowledge and understanding of places, environments and issues at more than one scale.
- Identify straightforward causes and consequences of change and show some understanding of how people's actions, including their own, can improve or damage the environment

#### <u>Art/DT</u>

• Be able to control a range of materials, tools and techniques to achieve a variety of outcomes.

### <u>Science</u>

- Find and use a variety of evidence, information and ideas.
- Use scientific knowledge and skills to plan their enquiries and predict outcomes.
- Organise and communicate their findings using relevant scientific language and display these in tables, bar charts and in simple line graphs when the axes and scales are given.
- Identify patterns and trends.
- Use some scientific knowledge and understanding to explain their findings and differences between, or changes to organisms, materials and physical phenomena.
  Link the learning to similar situations.

### <u>ICT</u>

- Broadly plan their tasks and combine a variety of information and media when creating and developing their ideas, with a sense of purpose and audience
- Make simple predictions about how changing one variable affects another in models or simulations.

### In Literacy we will...

- speak clearly, using formal language and projecting or voices effectively to a large audience
- expand upon main idea(s) with supporting reasons, information and example
- use language appropriate to writing, including standard forms of English
- use different sentence structures, including complex sentences
- use the full range of punctuation to guide the reader in complex sentences, e.g. commas, speech marks and apostrophes for possession
- gather and organise information and ideas from different sources

### In RE we will...

- Describe and begin to explain the religious beliefs, teachings and practices investigated.
- Give specific examples of the ways in which these aspects affect believers' lives and begin to identify the similarities and differences within religions.

# In Music we will...

 Work with others, devise and undertake simple development of musical ideas to produce compositions, demonstrating understanding and appropriate use of musical elements.

### In Numeracy we will...

- check answers using inverse operations
- multiply and divide 3-digit numbers
- transfer mathematical skills to a variety of contexts and everyday situations
- identify the appropriate steps and information needed to complete the task or reach a solution
- select from an increasing range of checking strategies to decide if answers are reasonable
- use mental strategies to recall multiplication tables for 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 and use to solve division problems
- multiply and divide numbers and decimals by 10 and 100
- calculate fractional quantities, e.g. 1/8 of 24 = 3, so 5/8 of 24 = 15

## In PE we will ...

- Cooperate with others and observe the conventions of fair play, equality and appropriate conduct.
- Communicate our ideas clearly to others
