Language, Literacy and Communication

- Using pencils, pens, paint, chalk, finger paint etc. Have a go at writing the letter sound n, remember to start at the bottom, go up to the top, stop, go back down, up and over the mountain and flick to the right. Good luck with the cursive 'n' Mums and Dads. Hunt for 6 medium sized pebbles outdoors. Write the letter sounds s a t p i n, one letter on each pebble, see how many words you can make and sound out together- in, on, at, sat, tip, pin

Mathematics

- This week is all about counting and measuring. First go around the house and find things you'd like to measure. Then open your hand out wide (handspan) and count how many of your hand spans long the object you have chosen is. Maybe you are measuring a teddy or a book or a cushion? Take a guess first, then check by measuring to see if you were right.

Science and Technology

- This week I'd like you to find out about the creatures and plants that live in a rock pool. The weather is going to be nice this week maybe you could visit a beach (socially distancing of course) to look for rock pools. Take some pictures of what you find. Be careful not to fall in the rock pool and watch out for crabs! What's special about the water in a rock pool? Why do the creatures like to live there?

Humanities

- On 25th June this week it is the Dragon Boat festival, don't forget to hang up your perfume pouches and wear your dragon mask. You need to make a special sticky rice called zongzi to eat during the festival. Simple recipes can be found online, but if you prefer you could make rice pudding instead.

Expressive Arts

- Make a few tin foil boats with paper sails, ready to race on the Dragon Boat Festival day. Using a straw blow your boat across a tub of water, or the bath. Ask your family members to take part in the race and see who wins, good luck!!

Health and Wellbeing

- Find out how to keep yourself safe in the sun. Pack a sunbag or sunsack ready to use on a sunny day. What items will you put inside? (hat, bottle of water, suncream, wet wipes, t-shirt, umbrella etc) Why is it important to protect yourself from the sun?
