Comments made on social media will not be responded to and will not be counted as within the consultation responses – all queries/responses must be made through the portal, via email or in a letter. The consultation window opens on the

3rd November 2020 until the 19th January 2021.

The Governing Body will be submitting an objection which will include the thoughts and feelings of the staff and pupils.
