Art

Music - Pitch & Melody

- Explore "What is melody?" and how does melody compare and contrast in different types of music.
- Perform songs and describe how others' performances make them feel.

In Science and Technology we will...

Science - Sound & Hearing

- Investigate different sound sources and explore making different sounds, using appropriate vocabulary.
- Explore how sound travels.
- Research what inside of an ear look like and how it works.
- Investigate "Which material would be the best to use to muffle sound?"
- Share our findings and observations.

- Focus primarily on number work, such as, developing our understanding of place value, ordering numbers and estimating.
- Develop our ability to choose the appropriate operation to solve number problems, such as, addition and subtraction.
