In Health and Well-being we will...

- be learning about and understanding how to keep ourselves healthy by:-
 - Budgeting a healthy meal,
- Discussing and comparing costs of different foods.
- Look at ways in which we can look after ourselves and why.
 - Researching what role does sport play in charity work
- In PE, we will be playing a variety of team games (Hockey/netball), team building activities as well creating/performing a dance sequence.

In Science and Technology we will...

- Using spreadsheets to budget a healthy meal/shopping list.
- -Understanding how different foods can affect our teeth, the roles of different teeth when eating and how this aids digestion.
- Identifying any similarities and differences of mammals and humans in relation to teeth and eating.
- Learning how to protect ourselves and our information when using different social media platforms.

In Mathematics and Numeracy we will...

- Build upon prior learning of number bonds and using these in 4/5 digit numbers.
- Using the 4 operations of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing to solve a range of number problems.
- To use both mental and written strategies to answer questions and choose which strategy they prefer to use.
- Developing different strategies to aid our work using the 4 operations such as estimating and rounding.
- Understanding the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages.

In Humanities we will...

- Be understanding the term 'Charity work'.
- Researching different charity work being carried out across different communities/countries etc..
- The immediate impact this charity work has on certain groups of people.
- Understanding if Christians believe in charity towards people from other faiths.
- What's the difference between wants and needs?
- Who should give the most money to charity?
- Is there something important we can give to charities than money?
- What is a philanthropist?
- Planning our own charitable fundraiser.
