## Ysgol Gynradd RHOS Primary School Pupil Deprivation Grant Spend

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (e-FSM)

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals.

As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

- 1. to identify the target group of pupils, its characteristics and needs.
- 2. to plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources.
- 3. to monitor and evaluate the impact of resources.

In 2021 - 2022 Rhos Primary School was provided with an EYPDG/PDG allocation of £24,150

At Rhos Primary School we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Neath Port Talbot Local Authority and ERW, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding. We have used the funding available to:

- provide intervention and support programmes that are proven to have the greatest impact.
- provide specific high quality training for school staff in order for them to support vulnerable pupils effectively.
- support vulnerable groups of leaners by providing small group tuition/support/nurture.
- Improve planning and assessment systems within the school and further develop monitoring systems to identify learners' needs, target □interventions and monitor impact.
- support and extend learners experiences and opportunities to enhance their learning.
