Last night I met with Powys Headteachers and the local authority. We are all aware that restrictions are changing in Wales, however the operational guidance from Welsh government for schools has had little change. It is safe to say that a cautious approach is being taken.

With this in mind, we are trying to organise activities for the children in line with the risk assessment. I will send more information nearer the time but these are the activities planned so far.

Year 6 will be attending the Calon Cymru site for transition. We are waiting an update on how this will work. Powys are consulting with high schools at present regarding risk assessments.

We will be offering new starters transition, but are waiting on information from the high school so we can coordinate our days. Once this is agreed I will be contacting families.

All classes will be sharing an assembly with their parents on Hwb.

Year 6 enjoyed the production so much they have asked to do another one! We will share this with you. We will also organise a leaving party for the year 6, which will take place after school in their bubble only. Mrs Smith will be sending out information nearer the time!
