Cwpanau / Poteli Dŵr

Gofynnwn yn garedig i chi roi poteli plastig i'ch plant bob dydd. Nid ydynt yn gallu rhannu cwpanau plastig yr ysgol oherwydd perygl dal Covid-19.

Gwasanaethau

Ni fyddwn yn cynnal gwasanaethau ysgol gyfan ar hyn o bryd, ond byddwn yn parhau i wobrwyo plant a rhoi tystysgrifau iddynt. Bydd addoli torfol yn cymryd lle o fewn dosbarthiadau.

Addysg Gorfforol

Bydd gwersi addysg gorfforol yn dechrau cyn gynted â phosibl. Bydd y disgyblion i gyd yn medru dod i'r ysgol yn eu dillad addysg gorfforol gan fod prinder lle i newid yn ddiogel ar hyn o bryd. Byddwn yn cynnal pob gwern addysg gorfforol yn yr awyr agored ac bydd rhaid i ni ohirio gwersi mewn tywydd gwael. Ni fydd yn ddiogel i ni ganiatáu gweithgareddau lle mae plant yn anadlu'n drwm a chwysu o fewn cyfyngiadau'r neuadd. Bydd hyn efallai'n cynyddu risg trosglwyddo a dal Corona Virus.

Byrbrydau

Bydd llaeth ar gael ar gyfer plant Cyfnod Sylfaen o'r wythnos nesaf ymlaen (14.09.20), ac mae croeso i bob disgybl trwy'r ysgol ddod â ffrwyth eu hunain. Yn anffodus, ni fyddwn yn medru gwerthu tost, ffrwythau a frubes, fel arfer. Rydym yn annog eich plant i ddod â byrbrydau eu hunain i'r ysgol.

Hylendid

Ni fydd angen i'r plant cadw at reolau ymbellhau cymdeithasol, ond byddwn yn parhau i sicrhau eu bod nhw'n cadw eu dwylo'n lan. Bydd gorsfeydd golchi dwylo ym mhob ardal o fewn yr ysgol ac ni fyddwn yn caniatáu i fwy nag un plentyn fynd i'r tŷ bach ar y tro.

Mynediad i'r Safle

Yn anffodus, ni fyddwn yn medru derbyn rhieni ar y safle yn y bore. Fodd bynnag, mae un rhiant / oedolyn yn medru sefyll ar un o'r smotiau glas ar fuarth yr ysgol ar ddiwedd y dydd er mwyn casglu eu plant.

Gall rieni ddod mewn trwy apwyntiad neu wahoddiad yn unig.

Cydymffurfio â Rheolau Llywodraeth Cymru

Er mwyn lleihau perygl a risg trosglwyddo Covid-19, byddwn yn dilyn rheolau Llywodraeth Cymru:

Dear parents

I hope that you have all continue to keep well. We are delighted that your children have returned to school and we now eagerly looking forward to welcoming our nursery children back this week.

Updates to arrangements for returning to school – Autumn Term September 2020

Illness

Do not send your children to school if they are ill, especially if they display the following symptoms:

- Continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss of taste and / or smell

If you are concerned about your child's health, phone 111 to seek advice or arrange a Covid-19 test. We are working hard to keep the school open and one positive diagnosis of Covid-19 will mean closing whole classes and children having to self-isolate for 14 days.

Cups/ Water Bottles

We kindly request that you provide your child with a water bottle every day as we cannot permit them to use and share school beakers. This will increase the risk of transmitting and contracting Covid-19.

Assemblies

We will not be holding whole school assemblies at the moment, but will continue to award certificates. Collective worship will take place within individual classrooms.

Physical Education

PE lessons will resume as soon as possible. Pupils should come into school wearing their PE kit as there is currently lack of space for them to change safely. All PE lessons will be held outdoors and lessons will be postponed during poor weather conditions. We cannot allow pupils to be running around in the confines of the hall, breathing heavily and sweating more than usual as this will possibly increase the risk of transmitting and contracting Covid-19.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will start back on Monday, September 14th.

After school clubs

We will not be in a position to run after-school clubs in September because of the rules about mixing "bubbles" of children.

Personal belongings

We cannot permit toys and other personal items to come into school from the home.

Snacks

Milk will be available for Foundation Phase pupils (nursery – Year 2) from Monday September 14th and pupils throughout the whole school will be welcome to bring their own fruit into school. Unfortunately, we cannot sell toast, fruit and frubes as we used to do. We encourage children to bring their own snacks to school.

Hygiene

Children will not have to abide by the rules of social isolation, but we will continue to make sure they keep their hands clean. There will be hand washing stations in every area of the school and we will not allow more than one child to go to the toilet at any one time.

Access to the Premises

Regrettably, we will not be able to accept parents on the premises in the morning. However, one parent / adult per family can stand on one of the blue spots on the playground at the end of the day to collect their child.

Parents may come into school via an appointment or invitation.

Complying with Welsh Government

In order to reduce the danger and risk of transmitting Covid-19, we will adhere to the following Welsh assembly guidelines:

- Staff will keep 2 metres apart from each other.
- Everyone will wash their hands regularly.
- Junior classes will be sat in rows, next to each – not facing each other.
- We will continue, as far as possible, to avoid the sharing of resources.
- Current and existing systems for travelling around the school will remain in order to avoid overcrowded corridors and two way traffic.
