	<u>Spellings</u> Download the free apps Glitter Draw or Mow it and write each spelling word.  	<u>Spelling</u> Type your spelling words on Jit Write. Try changing the colour and font each time you write a word.	<u>Spelling/Sounds</u> Today is spelling test day! Send in your scores to Mr Young for Dojo points.	<u>Spelling/Sounds</u> Find objects that start with the letters of some/all of your spelling words e.g. C- carrot A- apple T-toaster	<u>Spelling/Sounds</u> Write your spelling words on pieces of paper and spread them around the floor. Ask a parent to shout out each spelling word and throw a toy on to that word. Swap over and test your parents to see if they can find each word!
	<u>Numeracy</u> Go on a shape hunt in your house, garden and on your daily walk. What shapes did you find? Did you know all the shapes or did you learn some new shapes?	<u>Numeracy</u> Collect some shapes around your house (If they are 3D and you are not sure of the names either as a parent and practice learning them or use the 2D shape name that you know) sort them by the number of sides and corners.	<u>Numeracy</u> Learn a new shape! Find an unusual shape around your house and use the computer to find out its name. How many sides does it have? Is it 3D (fat) or 2D (flat)?	<u>Numeracy</u> Draw around 2D shapes. Find some in the house or print some 2D shapes off and try drawing around the shapes. If you can use a ruler and try to draw your own shapes.	<u>Numeracy</u> Make a shape monster! Cut out shapes and fit them together to make a shape monster. Can you make a monster family? Take a photo and send to Mrs Meacham.
