

## Tricky Words Set 1 Read and Spell Checklist

The table below contains many of the **High Frequency Words** that children need to know how to read and in time, spell.

The first part of the table contains mainly **decodable words** (words whose letters make their regular phonic sound when the word is said).

The second part contains **tricky words**. They are **tricky words** because some or all of the letters do not make their regular phonic sound when the word is said. These words need to be read and learned as sight words, your child may already know some of them.
