### Dates for your diary -

**Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October** - School photograph day.

**Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October – Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> October** – Harvest collection for the local food bank. We would be very grateful if you could make a donation of tins/cereals/pasta,etc (no later than Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>) as part of our Harvest celebrations.

**Coats** – please ensure that your child wears a coat to school every day. Staff use the outdoor classroom for a variety of activities and we try to use the outdoors as much as possible.

**School lunches** - A menu for school lunches is available on our school website. If your child would like a school dinner please pay in advance through Parentpay (unless your child is entitled to free school meals). **The cost of a school lunch is £2.35 per day. (£11.75 per week).**

**Attendance** – if your child is absent from school you **must** inform the school office with the reason for your child's absence.

Safety notice – I am receiving many complaints from the school crossing patrol, parents and local residents about parents who park directly outside the Foundation Phase building on the yellow zig zags and the single yellow line and at the entrance to the car park at the drop off and pick up point for our school buses. The buses must have access to the car park to bring some of our children to school and to take them home at the end of the day. Parking in these areas is putting everyone at risk. It is really dangerous and inevitably, if parents continue to park illegally, accidents are going to happen. Please be considerate to others and park further away from the school and if possible, make the journey to school on foot. Unfortunately, because these parking issues happen on a regular basis, Enforcement Officers have been informed and will be patrolling the area regularly. Please think of the safety of others especially our Cwmafan Primary School pupils. Thank you.
