

Digital task: Practise helping Mum/ Dad/ your carer with uploading your photos of you completing tasks to your 'My files', on J2e in your Hwb account.</p>	<p>Creative Development Tasks 6:</p> <p></p> <p>1. Make a caterpillar out of painted circles/ painted stones or egg boxes.</p> <p>2. Make a home for a chosen mini beast out of materials you find in your garden or house. </p> <p>3. Create your favourite mini beast using pencils/ paint /crayons /chalks/ cakes/biscuits etc.</p>
<p>Physical Development Tasks 7:</p> <p></p> <p>1. *Leaf threading using string and a hole punch.</p> <p>2. ** Move like insects around your garden or house, following instructions from Miss Niki.
