# **Return of school**

I hope you and your families are all safe and well. Now that schools have the operational guidance from Welsh Government, please find below initial details regarding the safe return to school for our 3 -7 yr olds. Unfortunately, we are still operating in abnormal times, however, there is now more hope that the next few months will start to see a gradual and cautious return to school for all pupils.

#### What we know:

After half-term, primary schools will have three priorities, addressed in this order:

- 1. Educating and keeping 3-7 year olds in Nursery to year 2 onsite
- 2. Educating years 3 to years 6 offsite
- 3. Onsite learning for vulnerable/critical worker children in years 3 to years 6 only where essential and in need of **EMERGENCY** childcare. Places are limited, as more staff will be needed to return to face to face teaching in the infant classes.

# **Arrangements for week beginning Monday 22**<sup>nd</sup> **February** Foundation Phase pupils (3-7yr olds):

- 1. Monday and Tuesday (22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> February) are planning days no pupils onsite
- 2. Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> staggered return for the pupils onsite

Spaceships/Rockets/Rainbows: Wednesday - half the class return

Thursday - half the class return
Friday - all class to return

Morning and afternoon nursery: Wednesday - 1/3 class return

Thursday - 1/3 class return Friday - 1/3 class return Monday March 1<sup>st</sup> - all pupils return

(Parents of the above pupils will be notified tomorrow morning of their start day. Times and entry points see table below)

- 3. Breakfast club will remain closed until further notice
- 4. School lunches will resume Monday March 1<sup>st</sup> (pupils to bring sandwiches and snacks/drinks until this time)
- 5. Classes will remain in their contact bubbles throughout the school day. No contact with other classes.















- 6. All pupils to wear school uniform and suitable outdoor clothing for inclement weather
- 7. Parents must wear face coverings at the school entrance/exit point. Please make an appointment with the school office if you need to speak to a member of staff.
- 8. Parents MUST ensure they follow social distancing guidance, think twice before sharing lifts to schools, sharing childcare, should not be holding parties/sleepovers, mixing on the way to school, whilst on school premises or afterwards.

### KS2 pupils (Yr3- Yr6):

- 1. Monday February 22<sup>nd</sup> planning day for staff no pupils onsite (including emergency childcare)
- 2. Tuesday February 23<sup>rd</sup> online/blended learning will resume
- 3. Tuesday February 23<sup>rd</sup> **EMERGENCY** childcare for vulnerable & critical workers resumes. Only those who are critical workers in need of **EMERGENCY** childcare should consider sending their children into school. Places are limited, as more staff will be needed to return to face to face teaching in the infant classes. Onsite learning will still be offered to those who need it as opposed to those who want it. However, critical worker eligibility does not guarantee your child a place.
- 4. Entrance 8.50am main doors at front of school
