

1. The school follows the All Wales Child Protection procedures and the school policy is consistent with guidance issued by the All Wales procedures and the ERW Model Policy was adopted in December 2016. All staff and students are briefed annually regarding Child Protection procedures and staff undertake full CP training every three years.
2. Staff access relevant training events and dissemination of information takes place at regular intervals. Records are kept securely by Miss K Lawlor and Mrs Rhian Richards.

The Child Protection Officer (CPO) undertakes training every three years and attends Coordination meetings annually. Close liaison takes place between the Child Welfare Manager, Pupil Learning Coordinators and the CPO.

3. The school refers incidents which are appropriate and relevant to Social Services/police.
4. Child Protection is part of the PSE curriculum throughout Key Stages 3 and 4. The Childline telephone number is in all Pupil Planners. The message 'Be Safe' is regularly reinforced in assemblies and posters are positioned strategically around the school, giving contacts and information.
5. The last Estyn Inspection reported that the school has appropriate policies and procedures in place for safeguarding pupils.
