In Class

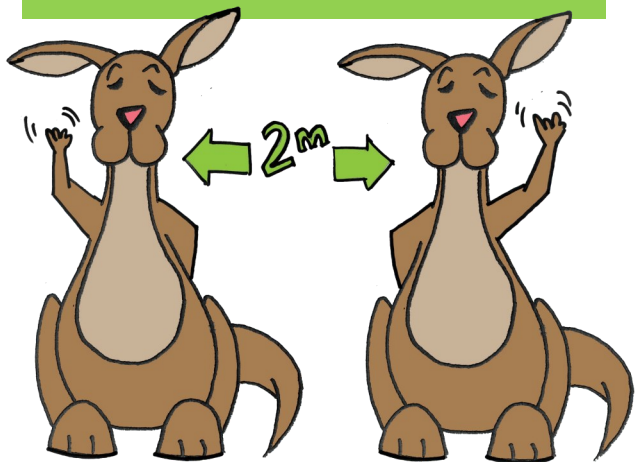
Pupils should maintain a 2m social distance from their teachers and Teaching assistants.

Desks in rooms are facing forward and should not be moved.

Stationery – pupils should bring their own stationery and not borrow from anyone.

At the start of every lesson pupils will be given antibacterial wipes to wipe down their chair/desk/chrome book, and dispose of the wipes safely in the bins provided.

There are antibacterial dispensers at the entrance/exit points in the buildings and also there are antibacterial gels in the classrooms.



Around the School

At Gowerton a pupil's year group is their 'bubble'. Pupils will be expected to remain with their year group in their zones and NOT mix with pupils from other year groups.

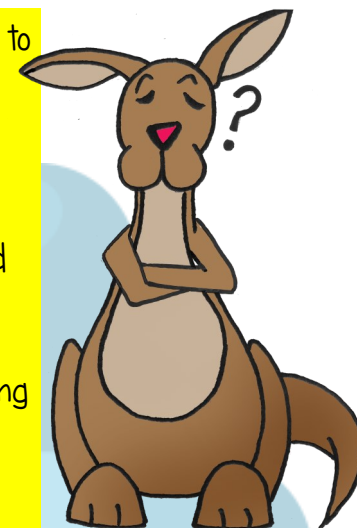
When pupils are dismissed from class they will follow the one way system. Travel time has been built into the timing of the day to allow pupils to maintain safe movement around the school.

Behaviour

Pupils are reminded that it is essential to maintain a high standard of behaviour throughout the school day but also in transit to/from school.

The main focus will be on learning and catching up on work missed.

We appreciate everyone's understanding and support whilst we adjust to a new way of operating.



Extra-Curricular

Unfortunately we cannot hold any extra curricular activities or trips.

There will be NO lunchtime clubs. No training, sporting fixtures, rehearsals etc. for the foreseeable future.

This will be reviewed on a monthly basis.



Lunchtime

The canteen is **closed** for the first 2 weeks, until Mon 14th September.

From Monday 14th there will be a limited, 'take away' style menu. Wherever possible we recommend that pupils bring in their own packed lunch.

The Squid system will require parents to top up and monitor their child's balance on line. The cashless top up machines in school will not be available.

Pupils will remain in outdoor zones but when it is raining pupils will go to their classroom for period 4.



Hand/Face Hygiene

Masks will be worn in indoor communal areas e.g. school buses, corridors, canteen.

Pupils are reminded to wash hands more frequently than normal, for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.

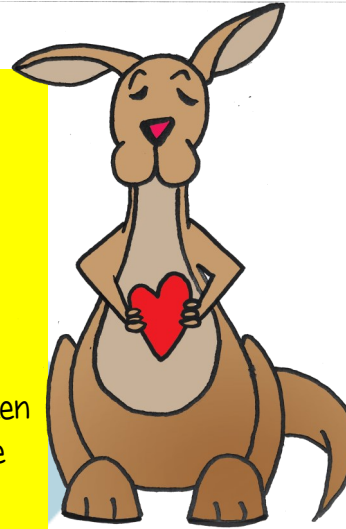
Hand sanitizer stations are located in all classrooms and throughout the school at entry and exit points.

The school promotes the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach regarding respiratory hygiene.

Feeling unwell

Pupils should not attend school if they have any possible Covid symptoms.

If anyone feels unwell after they've arrived in school they should report to Gofal. If the symptoms are deemed to be possible Covid symptoms (temperature, continuous cough, lack of sense of taste/smell) pupils will be taken to a medical isolation room and parents will be contacted.



Visitors to School

Parents **must not enter** the school site without an appointment.

Pupils being driven to school by parents will need to be dropped off outside the school gates.
