**Christmas Concerts**

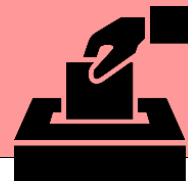
Thank you to all those who were able to attend the concerts over the past week. We were sold out in almost all of the shows and the staff were thrilled with the warm atmosphere within each of them.
