**Daily Do's- These are the different things that we do in school every day.**

- Phonics- practise the learning the letter sound by sight and using the letter formation jingles to help you write the sound. There are Phonics videos on the website which can help you with this.
- Practise counting to 10, forwards and backwards.
- Singing nursery rhymes, choose a different rhyme for each day!
- Practise recognising the sounds in your name.
- Days of the week, what day is it today? Teach your grown-ups at home our days of the week song.
- The weather, we talk about the weather in English and Welsh. Teach your grown-ups at home our weather song... Sut mae'r tywydd heddiw...
- Reading stories choose a story to share every day. Talk about the pictures with your grown-ups at home, what is happening? How are the characters feeling? What do you think will happen next? There is a Cbeebies Bedtime story app, you can download it for free and there are lots of different stories!

**This week:**

- First, watch the story The Rainy Day-

Can you answer the following questions about the story:

1. What are clouds made up of?
2. Where do the birds huddle?
3. Who likes the rain?
4. When can you see a rainbow?

- Make your own weather diary of the day, what is the weather like today in Godre'rgraig. Draw pictures of the weather and begin emergently writing underneath 'the weather today is...'. You can upload to HWB so I can see them.
- I have shared some initial sounds to your HWB files, can you practise writing these sounds on JIT, using the letter formation jingles to help you! Do not forget to click **save**! You can practise as many times as you want, use different colours too! Next, can you find different things in your house that begin with these sounds! What can you find?
- This week we will be practising using money! Set up a pretend shop in your homes with any items that you have, label the items in your shop using sticky labels with amounts on (e.g. 1p, 5p etc.). Practise using coins to count out the amount to match the price tag (4p you would count out 4 coins, 8p you would count out 8 coins). Start with numbers and objects 1 to 5 but if your child can complete this easily then try 1-10.
- You can play the Top Marks Money Game (see link below). Click the option counting to 10p using 1p coins.

- In the story, the Rainy Day there are big puddles and they get smaller and smaller! Can you find lots of different items in your house and put them in size order, starting with the smallest and finishing with the biggest! Take a photo of what you find!
- Take part in the BBC Teach listening game- Outside Sounds. Draw pictures of the sounds that you can hear!

- Make your own rainy day picture using paints, pens, chalks or anything else that you have at home! You could even use water to make your pictures!
- Take part in the Cosmic Kids We're Going on a Bear Hunt yoga, can you hear sounds that we heard in the Rainy Day story too?
