Daily Do's- These are the different things that we do in school every day.

- Phonics- practise the learning the letter sound by sight and using the letter formation jingles to help you write the sound. There are Phonics videos on the website which can help you with this.
- Practise counting to 10, forwards and backwards.
- Singing nursery rhymes, choose a different rhyme for each day!
- Practise recognising the sounds in your name.
- Days of the week, what day is it today? Teach your grown-ups at home our days
 of the week song.
- The weather, we talk about the weather in English and Welsh. Teach your grown-ups at home our weather song... Sut mae'r tywydd heddiw...
- Reading stories choose a story to share every day. Talk about the pictures with your grown-ups at home, what is happening? How are the characters feeling? What do you think will happen next? There is a Cbeebies Bedtime story app, you can download it for free and there are lots of different stories!

Can you answer the following questions about the story:

- 1. Where does Elmer shelter from the storm?
- 2. What is Elmer looking for?
- 3. Who helps Elmer?
- 4. How does Elmer feel at the end of the story?
- Record the weather for your local area for the week (like we do in school!). Draw pictures of what the weather is like on each day. Today in Godre'rgraig the weather is....
- I have shared some initial sounds to your HWB files, can you practise writing these sounds on JIT, using the letter formation jingles to help you! Do not forget to click save! You can practise as many times as you want, use different colours too! Next, can you find different things in your house that begin with these sounds! What can you find?
- Elmer's rainbow counting! Write numbers 1-5 (or 1 to 10 if your child recognises 1-5) on small pieces of paper. Find different items that you have at home (which are rainbow colours). You will need to show your child a number and they will need to count out the right amount of objects which matches the number e.g. if you show the number 3, your child will need to count out 3 objects, if you show number 8 your child will need to count out 8 objects.
- Weather listening game- follow the link below to play the weather sounds listening game. What sounds can you hear? Draw pictures of the weather sounds that you can hear!

- Elmer's colour sorting, I have shared this activity to your HWB files. Click on Shared Files do not forget to click edit in the top left-hand corner. Click save too!
- Create your own Elmer the elephant, you could use paints, sponges, pens, pencils, crayons. Do not forget to make him very colourful!
- If you have paints at home, you could explore colour mixing. We have started to learn about colour mixing in school, what colours mix to make a new colour?
