Reminders

- When bringing/collecting your child to/from School please keep a distance of 2 meters, we also request that everyone wear a face covering.

- As the doors and windows will be open to allow the best ventilation, please remember to dress your child in warm clothing and always provide a waterproof coat.
- Please provide water daily so that your child keeps hydrated.
- All pupils will have individual work packs, there will not be a need for a pencil case
- All pupils will use hand sanitizer at regular intervals together with washing their hands with soap and water

Reception/Year 1 at 3.20pm; Year 1 /2 at 3.22pm; Year 3 /4 at 3.25pm; Year 4 /5 at 3.27pm; Year 5 /6 at 3.30pm
