### **Free School Meals (FSM)**

The Welsh Government have introduced an annualised net earned income threshold for Universal Credit claimants who wish to claim free school meals for their children. We have information in school which is also available on the school website.

In Powys eligibility for free school meals is assessed by the Income & Awards Team. Although the majority of FSM are awarded on this basis parents/carers may register for FSM by applying online - <https://en.powys.gov.uk/article/3758/Free-school-meals-and-help-with-school-clothing>
