### SCHOOL MEALS – NO DEBT POLICY

You will recall that as of 1 September 2017, Swansea Council adopted a no-debt policy relating to the payment and provision of school meals. This was to ensure that, other than where there is an entitlement to free school meals, parents or carers pay for children's meals.

Please can you pay all outstanding debt immediately if you are currently in arrears. **Note that from after the Easter holidays if your child has a debt of more than 5 meals the online system will not allow them to request a meal.** There are a number of options available on the sQuid system to ensure there is sufficient funding available at all times for your child to have lunch, including automatic top-ups and direct debits.
