<p style="text-align: center;">Oracy</p> <p>Make a 5-minute presentation to deliver to the class on any topic or area of interest of your choice. How you choose to present is entirely up to you!</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>This will need to be ready by the 24th February</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Make a leaflet showing how to be safe when next to or near rivers. You might need to do some research prior to creating your leaflet. Your leaflet needs to be informative, accurate and concise.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <p>Create a river scene. You can use any style of your choice e.g. draw/paint a picture or make a collage or model. Be as creative as you want!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <p>Write a poem about a river or a river creature. You should look to use as much interesting vocabulary and technical words as possible.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Science and Technology</p> <p>Create a fact file about a famous river from around the world. Include as many interesting facts, data and details as possible.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy</p> <p>Plot a bar chart showing the different lengths of 5 different rivers in the UK. (Graph paper is available upon request)</p>
