Remember to give your story an exciting beginning, middle and end. Think about speech marks, adventurous vocabulary, punctuation, spelling, paragraphs and check your work makes sense- read it back to yourself or a family member.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Food Technology</p> <p>Bake something tasty for your family (with the help of an adult for safety reasons of course). Make sure you measure and weigh quantities accurately yourself, write out the instructions using 'bossy' verbs and take a photograph of your finished bake- upload it to HWB to show your class when you return to school.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <p>Draw or paint a picture of a local scene either from memory or from a picture you have located online. Make it a happy place. Bring your picture into school to show your friends when we come back to school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science & Numeracy</p> <p>Complete a weather survey for seven days or more. Choose your own way to record the weather for each day. Include your own observations, as well as information on your locality from websites. Data recorded could include; minimum and maximum temperatures, wind speed and direction and total rainfall each day.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Information Technology</p> <p>Research a hero or villain from any walk of life (historical, sporting, literary, family etc). Create an informative fact file that is bright, eye-catching and helpful to you when we return to school and look at 'Heroes & Villains' as a new topic in class.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <p>Make a card or a picture that will cheer up an elderly person in a local care home.
