## Home Learning Choice Menu – History of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century & Earth and Space

<p><b>Language, Literacy &amp; Communication</b></p> <p>Create a 5-minute presentation to present to the class on <b><i>a topic of your choice</i></b>. How you choose to present is entirely up to you.</p> <p><b><u>This will need to be ready by Monday 2nd November (giving you half term as well to prepare fully).</u></b></p>	<p><b>Humanities</b></p> <p>Write a newspaper report about any important event from the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Think about what happened, when and why it was historically significant. Set out your news report like a newspaper front page, include a newspaper name, a clever headline, write in columns, use the words of eye-witnesses &amp; add a picture.</p>
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p> <p>Copy or create a picture of a scene from any decade of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. You can use any medium you choose (pencils, felt-tips, paint, ICT etc.)</p>	<p><b>Health &amp; Wellbeing</b></p> <p>Research how people managed to keep fit and motivated throughout the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. You can focus on a wide range of areas including how exercise and fitness regimes developed through the years, diets, medicine, famous sporting events and icons as well as any other areas that interest you. How you choose to present your findings is up to you.</p>
<p><b>Science &amp; Technology</b></p> <p>Create a fact-file about a Planet of the Solar System of your choice. Make sure that you include relevant facts, data and information. Present your research on one page - this can be done using ICT and uploaded to Google Classroom on HWB.</p>	<p><b>Mathematics &amp; Numeracy</b></p> <p>Create a poster displaying number related facts (Infographic) about any events from the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Present your page in a bright &amp; attractive manner. Facts could be; <b><i>600,000,000 people watched the moon landing in 1969.</i></b> Or, <b><i>The Titanic cost \$7,500,000 to build in 1912.</i></b></p>

Please don't forget there is **ALWAYS** weekly spellings and tables tests to practise. Reading should also be done as often as possible. MyMaths and TT Rockstars are great 'at home' resources to help your child with in class maths.
