REMINDERS ABOUT COVID-19 GUIDANCE AND SELF-ISOLATION

What to do if your child has symptoms:

If your child has any of the main symptoms of COVID-19:

- Get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if they have COVID-19 as soon as possible
- Your child should stay at home and not have visitors until you get the test result - they should only leave your home to have the test.
- If the test comes back positive, inform the school immediately. We will need a copy of the test result. If you receive a negative result, we will also need to see a copy of the test result prior to your child entering the building.

The rules on self-isolation changed on August 7th. The current rules for Wales, are outlined below:

1. People who test positive must self-isolate for 10 days, as previously.
2. People aged 18 or over who are not fully vaccinated, or were fully vaccinated overseas, must self-isolate if they are a contact of a positive case.
3. Fully vaccinated people (vaccinated in the UK) aged 18 or over and children do not have to self-isolate if they are contacts.
4. Fully vaccinated people (vaccinated in the UK) aged 18 or over and children who are contacts of a positive case will instead be asked to take PCR tests on Days 2 and 8 following their last contact with the positive case.
5. If at any point they develop symptoms, they must self-isolate and seek a PCR test. If negative, they can return to school if symptom-free. If they test positive, they must self-isolate (as per Point 1).
