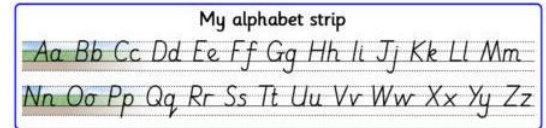


# Language, Literacy & Communication

## Outcome 1



### Oracy

To listen to and join in with songs and rhyme.

To follow spontaneous one-step instructions.

To 'talk' to themselves, other children and familiar adults using simple sentences.

To talk about familiar objects, use newly learned words in their play.

To imitate real-life and make-believe experiences and verbalise within symbolic play.

To begin to take part in activities alongside adults or other children.

### Reading

Children understand the basic structure of reading materials.

To follow texts read by a familiar adult and start to volunteer information about familiar texts.

To begin to recognise differences and similarities in pictures, shapes, patterns and textures.

### Writing

To experiment with making purposeful marks, shapes and symbols, and start to use implements in either hand.

To use scribbles, shapes or pictures to express a sentence.
