Outcome 3



Recite up to 20 forwards and backwards and count up to 10 objects reliably.

To read, write, compare and order numbers to 10 and understand that zero means none.

To understand simple addition and subtraction sums and mentally recall one more and one less with 10.

To use 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins to pay for items.

To make sensible estimate up to 10 and understand that this can be checked by counting.

To use direct comparisons and simple language when measuring and understand that measurements must start at the same point.

To recognise 2D and 3D shapes, describe them in simple terms.

To recognise and repeat patterns of up to 3.

To sort objects using one criterion.

To record collections using marks, numbers or pictures.

To move in given directions.
