

Dear Parent/ Carer,

Last week, we informed you of new drop off and collection arrangements from the 28<sup>th</sup> September. The Welsh Government recently reported a rise in infection rates in Wales and brought in several new measures. In light of the new restrictions, we will have to continue with the current drop off and collection arrangements for the foreseeable future; dropping off at School Street (infants with junior siblings) & Heol Wenallt (juniors) and no adults on the school premises, to ensure the safety of all of our families.

The start time will remain at **8:40 am** and the window to bring in the children will be until **9:00 am**. Pick up time will be from **3:00 pm** until **3:20 pm** in the **Infants** and **3:10 pm** until **3:20 pm** in the **Juniors** (with Mrs Lewis' class leaving first). This arrangement has worked very well to date and the children are confidently following this routine.

Breakfast Club will start on 28<sup>th</sup> September and can only be accessed with a consent form- if you haven't completed one of these in the past please note your child's KIT book and one will be sent home. We would ask that you *only* use this facility if there is no other means of child care at home. We have a very small school hall and the operational guidance states we can only sit pupils in their class bubbles with space in between each group. If numbers are at a level where this is not possible, we may have to restrict entry.

Parents can come into the yard to drop children off at the infant door for **Breakfast Club only** from **8:10 to 8:30 am** and a member of staff will sign your child in to avoid parents sharing pens and accessing the school. Parents should then leave the yard straight away to avoid gatherings.

These are ever changing times and we really appreciate your cooperation as we work to keep in step with the guidance for schools and keep you all safe.
