Focus on decoding words and developing a range of other strategies to improve the pupils' reading age.	Spring & Summer 2022	Impact measured through Salford reading scores, Incerts data and guided and shared reading.	
To identify and improve the outcome of FSM Foundation Phase pupils in literacy using Incerts levels & internal assessments from July 2021- focusing on Basic Skills pupils.	Summer 2022	Impact measured through PM targets, Incerts tracking and internal assessments.	

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Action 2 To identify and improve the outcome of FSM pupils in number to improve their application of number skills across the curriculum.	Summer 2022	Impact measured through Incerts tracking, maths assessment data and monitoring- listening to learners.
