

Y4 Areas of Learning and Experience - Summer

Topic - The Amazonian Rainforest

Where in the world are rainforests located? What is the structure of a rainforest? What wildlife lives there? What is the impact of deforestation?

Language, Literacy and Communication

Inc: English, Welsh and ICT.

This term, Year 4 will be focusing on poetry and persuasive writing. They will have the opportunity to read a range of texts to research information and read for pleasure.

In writing sessions they will continue to consolidate their accuracy in using spelling, punctuation and grammar. They will be encouraged to check and edit their written work with greater independence.

Year 4 will be applying their language skills across all areas of the curriculum and will use ICT to enhance and present work. They will be continuing to use Welsh on a daily basis through simple greetings and questions.

Science and Technology

During Year 4's Science work this term, they will be encouraged to record observations along with ideas about what is happening and why. They will be investigating 'Circuits' and 'Habitats' using scientific terminology to record accurately.

Humanities and RE

Inc: Geography and History

The children will be interpreting maps and learning about different climates. They will also learn about the Amazonian Rainforest.

Health and Wellbeing

Inc. PE, Personal and Social Education

Year 4 will be participating in athletics this term, developing skills in running, jumping and throwing.

Expressive Arts

Inc Music, Dance and Art

The children will reflect listen to and learn about the music of Bob Dylan.

The children will be encouraged to explore different cultures and identities.

Mathematics and Numeracy

This term the children will continue to reinforce their understanding of number and place-value. They will be encouraged to learn their multiplication facts.

Year 4 will complete word problems on a weekly basis to develop their reasoning skills and continue to experience situations which are related to real life scenarios.

The children will also have opportunity to use and apply their Mathematical skills across the curriculum.
