

If **anyone** in your household has a Covid test, it is **essential** that we receive a copy of the results **BEFORE** your child is authorised to return to school. We need sight of all results – positive or negative so that we can respond appropriately. **We cannot accept children back at school without confirmation of the test result.***

***We are only able to accept PCR test results from testing centres. We cannot accept LFD test results. If you child needs a test due to showing symptoms, a PCR test is required.**


It is ESSENTIAL that ALL visitors wear a suitable FACE COVERING when entering on to school property. Thank you.
