

#### IMPORTANT:

Gatherings in the yard are still NOT permitted. Parents may enter onto our site with their children if necessary but please abide by the strict procedures and leave promptly.

We politely ask that face coverings for adults are still to be worn at all times when entering onto our school sites.



### **Broad Street Site:**

### Parents are not permitted to cross onto the main yard at the junior site.

- When accessing the back yard, please enter at the corner gate, continue along and leave site through the double vehicle gates immediately following the oneway system.
- 2. Please do NOT enter through the double vehicle gates.
- 3. Please DO NOT stop and gather on school site as this will block the exit and cause a 'bottle-neck'.
- 4. The children will line up with staff, as each parent **leaves site.** This will ensure the next families can safely drop their children off in a **continuous flow**.
- 5. Please arrive at the set times for your year group so that our year group 'Pods' can be kept separate.
- 6. Please join queues politely when dropping off or collecting your child as 'pushing in' often causes offence and unnecessary upset. Thank you.

# Please abide by the one-way systems in place around the yards.

Where a one-way system is not feasible, please be patient and courteous to others. Thank you for your help and support so far. We cannot achieve success without you!

# **Breakfast Club Arrangements**

Breakfast Club will resume on 6<sup>th</sup> September. It remains **highly restricted** in its operation to ensure we comply with strict rules on social distancing. We work hard to keep all of our pods separate when on school site during the day and Breakfast Club is no exception. Due to the size of our halls, we are only able to safely welcome **2 junior year group 'pods'** into Breakfast Club **per session** to ensure our pods remain at least 2 metres apart. This is hugely regrettable but is completely unavoidable. We are currently only able to invite Year 1 and Year 2 to be together at Breakfast Club.

Each pod will access Breakfast Club on their allocated days at **separate entrances**. This ensures the children from different pods **do not mix**. Please do not ask staff to admit siblings through the same door. They are not permitted to mix children once on site.

Numbers will be restricted per pod. Families will need to complete a form to apply for the provision (text out to parents). Spaces will be reserved on a first come first served basis. Once the numbers have been allocated, those who are unsuccessful when they initially apply will be added to the waiting list and contacted if numbers drop.

Children attending Breakfast Club will not access activities as sharing resources is not permitted. Children will need to sit at their designated table and not mix or play with children from other pods.



## **Breakfast Club at Broad Street:**

- Year 3 and Year 4 pods attend together but are kept separate.
- Year 5 and Year 6 pods attend together but are kept separate.
- Year 3 and Year 4 pods attend for a whole week and then Year 5 and Year 6 pods attend for the following week. This will continue to run on an alternate basis starting with Year 3 and Year 4 the week beginning 6<sup>th</sup> September.
- The year group pods will be seated 2 metres apart on separate tables.
- Each year group pod will access separate toilets.
- Broad Street Breakfast Club doors will open between at 8:15am and 8:25am.
- Each year group must enter through a separate door. Please see the grid below.
- All children must be registered with Breakfast Club using the form text to families.

## **Breakfast Club at Theodore Road:**

- Year 1 and Year 2 pods will attend together but be kept separate.
- There will be **no** Breakfast Club provision for Nursery or Reception pupils at this time.
- The year group pods will be seated 2 metres apart on separate tables.
- Each year group pod will access separate toilets.
- Theodore Road Breakfast Club doors will open between 8:25am and 8:35am.
- Each year group will enter through a separate door. Please see the grid below.
- All children must be registered with Breakfast Club using the form text to families.

Hopefully, these restrictions will be lifted as we progress through the Autumn term but until then, this is the most accommodating option we can safely provide in the current climate. Thank you for your understanding.
