This term we will be diving into the deep oceans to explore the aquatic creatures and life that lives below. Pupils will have the opportunity to learn about the layers of the ocean and the creatures that live there. This will link in nicely with our science topic of habitats. They will learn to use maps and explore google maps to view the Barrier Reef from space. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore their creative side during art sessions and will create clay sculptures of sea creatures. A blue abyss world has also been created for them on Minecraft Education giving them opportunity to dive into the oceans and explore via a digital platform. A big emphasis will also be made on the dangers of plastic pollution in our oceans and they will learn how they can help.
