I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter will be sitting the full GCSE Numeracy qualification this November. The dates for the examinations are as follows:

Numeracy Unit 1- Tuesday, 6th November, 9am

Numeracy Unit 2- Thursday, 8th November, 9am

Please note that this is the full GCSE Numeracy qualification.

As a school, to support their learning, we will be:

- Attaching them to a Maths teacher for registration to allow an additional 20 minutes Numeracy revision every day. In order for pupils to take full advantage of this, please can you ensure that your child is in school by 8:25am at the very latest.
- Providing topic specific revision during lunchtime or after school sessions.
- Providing pupils with revision material and past papers in the lead up to the examinations.

The extra sessions will run as follows:

- 11H1 Mr Lewis: Tuesday and Thursday lunchtime.
- 11H2 Mr Davies: Wednesday 3pm – 4pm.
- 11I1 Mrs Griffiths: Thursday 3pm – 4pm.

Please could you encourage your son/daughter to attend all of the revision sessions on offer so that they give themselves every chance to achieve their potential at the November examinations. In addition to this we would expect your son/daughter to be working independently at home. As a department, we value the home/school partnership and would encourage you to support and oversee your son/daughter's revision.
