

Travelling from Velindre, Cwmafan and Aberafan areas. Walk down station road towards the new Bus Station/Transport Hub. Cross the railway line using the station's pedestrian bridge. Walk through the station's car park to the new path that links the car park to the new Courts of Justice/A4241.

Keep on the right hand footpath and cross the entrance to LBS Builders Merchants. follow the footpath towards Blanco's Hotel. Walk around the corner to the entrance of the underpass by Blanco's. Walk along footpath on Water Street. Cross Water Street at the Pelican crossing opposite the Water Street Business Centre.

Cross Corporation Road using the traffic island. Continue walking crossing Wellington Place and Pembroke Terrace leading to Ysguthan Road. Walk down the road crossing Beach Street, Bevan Street and Pendarvis Terrace. Walk around the corner onto the pedestrian/cycle at the rear of Gerald Street.

Walk along Afan Way, crossing the roundabout by Neath Port Talbot Hospital. Walk along to the roundabout by Lidl/Morrisons.

Cross at the dropped kerbs and traffic island. Enter Village Road, and walk past the first pedestrian bridge. At the second pedestrian bridge cross Afan Way to Seaway Parade. Walk around the corner and cross Seaway Parade at the Puffin Crossing arriving at Bae Baglan.

Safer Places to Cross

A safe place to cross is somewhere where you are able to see in all directions. Stand away from any obstructions like road signs or junctions.

Common thing to avoid will be:

- Parked Cars
- Bends and Junctions

Moving away from parked cars and junctions is always the best option but not always possible.

Parked Cars

You won't be visible to car drivers when you cross by parked cars. You need to find a small gap. Check the cars each side of them won't be moving while you are between them. You can do this by checking for 4 signs:

- LIGHTS
- DRIVER
- EXHAUST FUMES
- ENGINE NOISE

Move slowly out to the edge of the cars to give you a clear view of traffic. Make sure to look RIGHT first as this is where cars will be coming closest. Look RIGHT, LEFT, then RIGHT again, if it is clear you cross. Looking and listening the whole time.

Junctions

If you can't avoid crossing at the junction, you need to check for cars like this:

- Start by standing somewhere they can see clearly down each of the roads at the junction.
- Looking over your right shoulder check each road in a 'circle'. Moving left, finishing with the road they started on.
- If anything is coming on ANY of the roads you should wait for the traffic to pass, and start the circle again.

Safe Routes to Ysgol Bae Baglan from Port Talbot Town

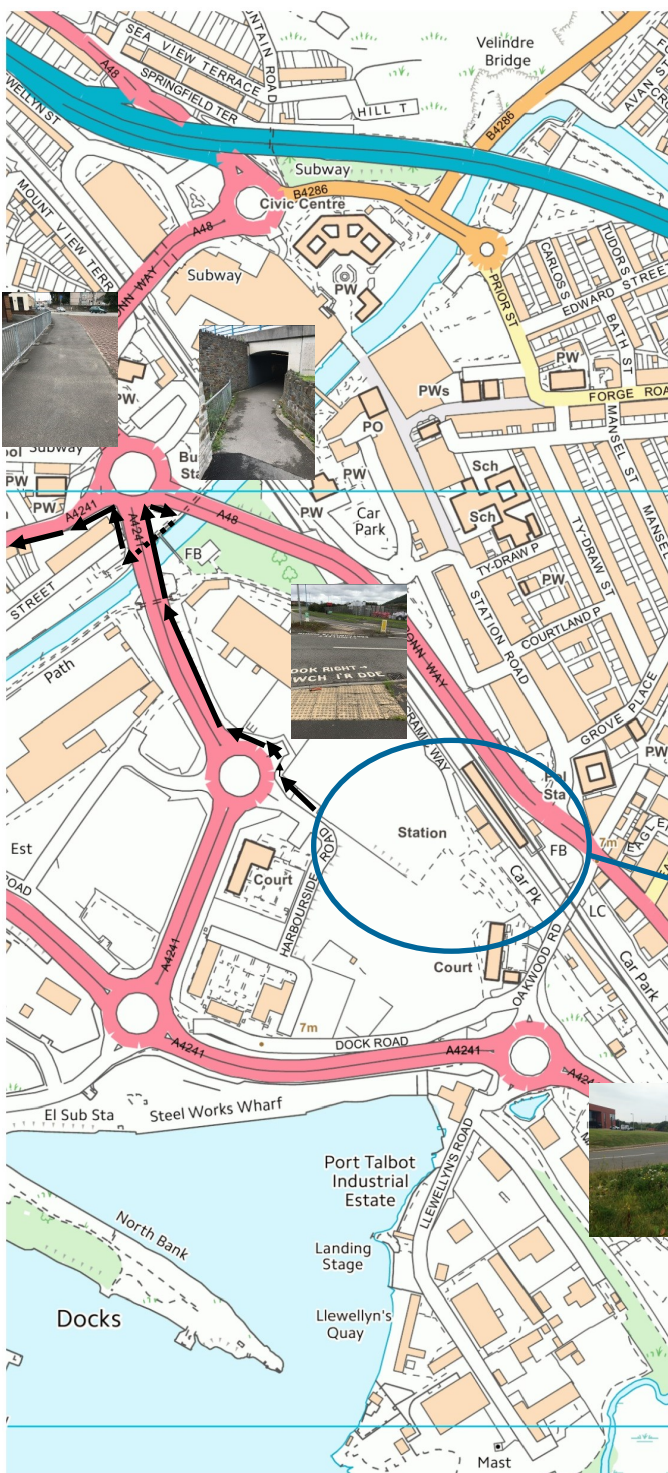
Neath Port Talbot's Road Safety Team has looked at walking and cycling routes to get to your new school. This leaflet tells you how to get to school as safely as possible.
