## Route 1 Blaenbaglan Primary (Blue Arrows)

Cross Maes Ty Canol at the red painted crossing point. Descend down the hill using the footpath that emerges on Church View. When you reach Church View, cross the road and bear left and continue down the hill entering Wells Road. Cross the mouths Sunnydale Road, Oakdene Close, and Fairwood Drive. Continue walking on the right footpath to the junction with Church Road.

Follow the corner around to the right onto Church Road towards Baglan Primary School. Walk. When it's safe to do so, cross Church Road and walk down Sunnycroft Road towards the junction with Sunny Mount. Cross the mouth of Sunnycroft Road (if necessary) and follow the Common Route.

#### Route 2 Baglan Primary (Black Arrows)

Starting at Baglan Primary School, bear right and walk down Elmwood Road. Cross the entrance to Baglan Education Training Centre. Walk to the end of Elmwood Road. Cross the mouth of Elmood Road. Continue to walk down Sunny Mount towards the roundabout. Cross Cedar Gardens and Sunnycroft Road.

#### Common Route (Green Arrows)

Walk down Sunny Mount on the left hand footpath, around the corner onto Pentwyn Baglan Road. Cross Pentwyn Baglan Road at the zebra crossing. Bear right and cross the mouth of Bagle Court and the entrance to the Bagle Brook restaurant /Premier Inn. Cross M4 slip road using the pedestrian footbridge. Enter the subway that links Baglan Train Station Car Park to Evans Bevans Playing Fields.

Bear right and walk along Seaway Parade, following the road right into Central Avenue. Cross Central Avenue at the puffin crossing. Walk along Central Avenue, crossing the mouth of Seaway Drive. Enter Ysgol Bae Baglan at the rear by turning left into Sirius Drive.

#### Safer Places to Cross

A safe place to cross is somewhere where you are able to see in all directions. Stand away from any obstructions like road signs or junctions.

Common thing to avoid will be:

- Parked Cars
- Bends and Junctions

Moving away from parked cars and junctions is always the best option but not always possible.

#### Parked Cars

You won't be visible to car drivers when you cross by parked cars. You need to find a small gap. Check the cars each side of them won't be moving while you are between them. You can do this by checking for 4 signs:

- LIGHTS
- DRIVER
- EXHAUST FUMES
- ENGINE NOISE

Move slowly out to the edge of the cars to give you a clear view of traffic. Make sure to look RIGHT first as this is where cars will becoming closest. Look RIGHT, LEFT, then RIGHT again, if it is clear you cross. Looking and listening the whole time.

#### **Junctions**

If you can't avoid crossing at the junction, you need to check for cars like this:

- Start by standing somewhere they can see clearly down each of the roads at the junction.
- Looking over your right shoulder check each road in a 'circle'. Moving left, finishing with the road they started on.
- If anything is coming on ANY of the roads you should wait for the traffic to pass, and start the circle again.

### General advice


- Wear something visible
