Your child will be sitting their Year 10 school examinations between March 9<sup>th</sup> and March 20<sup>th</sup> 2020.

These examinations are an essential part of the preparation for Year 11 and the GCSE's, some of which will be sat by pupils this summer. I know we will have your full support and cooperation in ensuring that your child fully prepares for these examinations. Please ensure you are aware of when your child has an examination and make sure that they arrive in school on time and with the correct uniform and equipment.

The timetable for the school examinations is on the reverse of this letter and on our school website under the Examinations Section. They will take place during lessons 1 -4 with session 1 starting at 8:45am and session 2 starting at 11:15am. They will be sat in either the Hall or the Activity Studio and your child will be given this information closer to the examinations. **If your child does not have an examination, they will attend lessons as per their normal timetable as full attendance is expected throughout this period.**
