Year 9 – Start on Friday 4th Sept, please enter school via the bottom fire exit technology door.

Year 10 – Start on Thursday 3rd Sept, please enter school via the hall fire exit doors, closest to the assembly entrance.

Year 11 – Start on Thursday 3rd Sept, please enter school via maths blocks or the main entrance by maths block 1 if your registration class is based in the main building.

Senior staff and your Wellbeing Directors will be on hand to help direct you to your rooms. There will be a lot to take in, but we will manage this together as a team to ensure we can safely start on our learning journey once again at school.
