



Year 11 Provisional Centre Determined Grades 2021

Dear Parent / Carer / Pupil,

As I'm sure you know Year 11 will be issued with their Provisional Centre Determined Grades between 9:15 and 11:00am on **Thursday June 17th**. These grades will be available from the school Activity Studio, accessed via the main reception area. These will be distributed to pupils in very much the same way that we would give out GCSE grades in August.

Please note that results for Vocational Qualifications including BTEC, Entry Level and Additional Mathematics will be issued on August 12th 2021.

Once in receipt of these provisional grades, if pupils are satisfied that the grade awarded is a true reflection of the effort and commitment displayed throughout years 10 and 11, there is no further action needed. However, if there is a query regarding the grade in a subject, it will be possible to request sight of the Individual Learner Decision Making Record (ILDMR) which explains how the grade was arrived at. This request must be made within 2 working days (48 hours) of receiving the results (Monday 21st June 3:00pm).

If a request is made to see the ILDMR, a senior member of staff will arrange to speak to your child to discuss the result(s) and any queries they might have. If following this conversation your child feels that there are grounds to review the grade given, they will need to complete a Centre Review Request Form.

All requests to review the provisional CDGs must be emailed to ybbcdg@npt.school between June 18th and June 28th 2021 at the very latest, accompanied by the centre review and appeals form which can be accessed [here](#). A review of the grade will take place and your child will be notified accordingly of the outcome.

Details of the WJEC guidance on the review of grades can be accessed [here](#). I must stress that all grades are provisional and subject to potential change. Finalised grades will be published on **Thursday 12th August 2021**.

Please note that only one adult will be permitted to accompany their child onto the school site. They must remain in the area at the front of the school until their child returns with their results.

In order to respect the education of other pupils within the school, we ask for pupils to leave the school site as soon as possible and to not gather at entrance gates or doorways.

We must remind you that if your child has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or if someone in their household has symptoms, they must not attend school to collect results. In this instance we can arrange for the results to be sent electronically.

You will appreciate that a huge amount of work has been put in to this process by pupils and staff and I would like to thank you all for the amount of support you have given us over these extraordinary times.
