What to do.

- 1. Ask someone at home to empty the change from his or her purse or pocket.
- 2. Without counting guess how much there is. Write down your estimate.
- 3. Now carefully count the cash. Write down the amount. How close was your estimate? Find the difference between the estimate and the actual amount.
- 4. Make a list of the coins and how many of each there are.
- 5. Give at least five different ways of making the same amount using different coins. Why not find as many different ways as you can?
