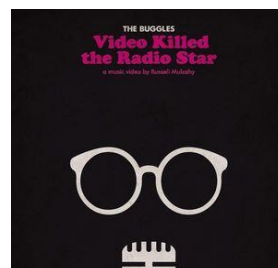
## Cluster Song and Dance event
