The warden checked our nails and hair for lice!




Our Year 5 and 6 pupils had a fantastic day yesterday, dressed and in role as evacuees, imagining the experience of being evacuated from London to Holt (many thanks for all your support in making sure they looked the part!). The children were met at Sheringham by the ARP warden and billeting officer. Everyone had to get heads down as soon as possible, as there was an unexploded bomb at Weybourne.



Arriving at Holt, all the evacuees had to put up with having their heads inspected for dirt and lice! During the day, the children were fully engaged in a range of activities, such as identifying and learning about German and British planes. They looked round a World War II house and did some of the chores, even emptying a chamber pot! They then made themselves a typical war time lunch, using non rationed ingredients such as SPAM for their sandwiches. The children also looked at the different types and sizes of gasmasks, from baby to adult ones, and saw examples of bombs which had been used.



All in all, a fabulous day was had by all, and our children were complimented for their manners and behaviour throughout the day.



My favourite part was going in the Anderson shelter with Brandon, it felt so real.

The best part was being in the air-raid. It was really scary but I can see how they would have felt.

My favourite part was the lunch, we could only have two small pieces of Spam. At home we have as much as we want!

Being on the train was the best, I actually felt like I was being evacuated.

I liked the part where we learned about the planes and re-enacted how they were spotted and how messages were sent.
