At the end of last half term we took a large number of pupils to Fairhaven for the cluster cross country competition. In windy conditions, all our pupils competed extremely well against the best runners from our cluster of schools.

Well done to all the children involved, some of whom came back with medals: Amelia Dibble (1<sup>st</sup> – Year 5/6 girls), Toby Scott (3<sup>rd</sup> – Year 5/6 boys), William Munford (1<sup>st</sup> – Year 3/4 boys), Tomas (2<sup>nd</sup> – Year 3/4 boys) and Ollie Scott (2<sup>nd</sup> – Year 1/2 boys). In the team competition, our Year 3/4 boys won gold, with 5 boys achieving high positions and gaining the highest overall score: William, Tomas, Sonny, Noah and Harry

The highest placed pupils from this event were then selected to take part in the cross country event at North Walsham Rugby club, where they competed against children from a wider range of schools in the East Norwich Sports Partnership area. This event served as a qualifying competition for the Norfolk School Games finals, to be held in March.
