2018-19 Key Stage Two Data

At the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6), children are tested against the objectives of the new National Curriculum. Reading, Writing and SPAG scores are based on tests taken in May, whilst Writing assessments are based on pupils' work over the course of Year 6. The schools' results can be compared to other schools nationally, based on this year's data. There were 26 pupils in Year 6, all of whom took the SATs tests.

The **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) test was introduced in 2013**. Schools do not measure progress in SPAG in the same way as in Reading, Writing or Maths because the children did not undergo a SPAG assessment in Key Stage 1 (Year 2).
