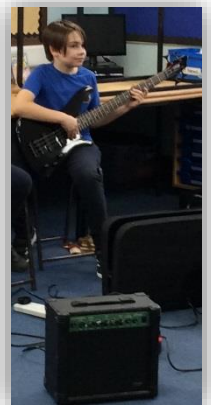

### Music lessons from Norfolk Music Hub

It is the turn of Year 6 to benefit from the whole class music lessons being provided by Mr Corfield from the Norfolk Music Hub. They will be experiencing a 'class band' approach over the Spring term, learning to play a range of instruments in the process.



### Booster lessons for Year 6

We have started our 'Booster' programme for Year 6, giving all the children in this year group an additional English and Maths lesson (in much smaller groups) on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon to support them in their learning of the key areas and skills in the core subjects. The group teaching enables all the children to get that additional attention and support, tailored to their particular needs. We shall be setting Maths homework based on the booster lesson each week from now on, with homework given out on Thursdays, for return the following Tuesday. We want to give all our Year 6 pupils every opportunity to excel in their SATs in May and to build up their confidence in tackling a range of questions similar to those they will face in the SATs tests. At the same time, we shall continue to provide an exciting, broad and challenging curriculum for them, as we do for all our pupils across the school.
