During the transition catch up session, children will be able to ask their current teacher any questions about next year and will also be able to meet their new teacher. We will be contacting any families by phone where there is no internet access, to discuss any issues.

We will be guided by our knowledge of our own school situation whilst adhering to government guidelines and advice from the local authority.
