



Site management in case of snow and/or icy conditions

We want to keep everyone who uses our sites safe at all times, especially when the school grounds could be affected by snow or by ice.

We've uploaded two maps to our school website which show how we are going to try to make sure that the paths are as safe as can be for all the people using the sites. Certain entrances and paths into school will be gritted on each site, other entrances or gates may be closed until conditions improve or the caretaker has a chance to make them safe later in the day.

Foundation Phase Site

If there are icy or snowy conditions which are affecting the site you will get a text message to your mobile phone on the number you have provided to the school.

- Breakfast Club pupils will enter the school through the main site entrance as usual.
- Nursery and Reception will enter school through the Nursery door (through the bottom gate)
- Year 1 and Year 2 pupils will use their usual way in through the main site entrance.

If conditions improve, pupils will be able to go out through their normal exits at the end of the day. You will get a text message to tell you which exit will be used.

Key Stage Two Site

If there are icy or snowy conditions which are affecting the site you will get a text message to your mobile phone on the number you have provided to the school. **Only the Walter's Road gate will be open for use before school.**

- Breakfast Club pupils will enter the school through the Year 6 entrance as usual.
- Year 3 and Year 4 will enter school through the Year 4 entrance (opposite the steps)
- Year 5 and Year 6 will enter school through the Year 6 entrance (opposite the demountable)

If conditions improve, pupils will be able to go out through their normal exits at the end of the day. You will get a text message to tell you which exit will be used.
